Rules

The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS) of World Sailing (WS) 2017-2020, the WS-Regulations, the class rules of the A-Cat class and this notice of Race.

The rules of procedure of the German Sailing Federation (DSV) apply.

If there is a conflict between languages
in case of Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS) the English text will take precedence
in all other Cases the German text will take precedence

Suitable life jackets shall always be worn whilst racing.

The corona rules described in the security concept must be strictly adhered to. The security concept with information on the largely contactless as well as the booked parking spaces process will be posted under "News & Stories" on https://www.raceoffice.org/Walchenfass2021_A_Cat_IDB on June 2nd. Disregarding this rules can lead to disqualification.

ADVERTISING

Boats may be required to display the advertising chosen and supplied by the organizing authority.

In the event of a violation, WS Regulation 20.9.2 may apply [DP]

Advertising by the participant must comply with WS Regulation 20 (Advertising Code)

ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

The regatta is open to all boats of the A-Class .

Each A-Cat sailor

- shall be a member of a club affiliated to a national authority of WS
- shall be a member of their national class association
- shall either have a valid sailing license of the German Sailing Federation (DSV), VDWS Cat certificate or a valid official license prescribed or recommended for the sailing area. Members of other national federations shall have an adequate sailing license of their national authority

Eligible boats must register via the portal www.raceoffice.org

www.raceoffice.org/Walchenfass2021 and immediately transfer the required entry fee to the account

The entry fee is EUR 90 per boat

In order to enable a largely contactless process, the Registration fees can only be paid online.

Registration will close Tuesday 1st of June at 24:00

Any entry only becomes valid after payment of the entry fee.

Whoever has registered must also pay the entry fee.

Any later entry will be subject to an entry fees of **€ 110,00** per boat

Late entries are accepted until **8th of Juni 24:00** .

The obligation to pay the entry fee does not cease to apply if the registration is withdrawn or if the boat is absent.

The entry fee will only be refunded if the registration is rejected or the event is canceled.

Social program is included in the entry fee.

INSURANCE

Each participating boat shall have a valid third party liability insurance with a minimum coverage of € 1.500.000 per incident, or the equivalent

REGISTRATION

scanned or photographed copies of

- boat measurement form
- mast measurement form
- sail measurement form
- insurance document, valid for 2021
- Informal consent from the parents of underage participants

shall be send by e-mail to vorstand@a-cat.de no later than Wednesday **8th of Juni 18:00** .

Food stamps, sponsor stickers, souvenir prizes, etc. will be delivered in marked paper bags. Only personal collection leads to a final effective registration. Details will be given in an information communicated together with the security concept on **June 2nd**.

Participants who do not register in time before the standby time to go out for the 1st race are not allowed to start.

MEASUREMENT

During the regatta any boat and its equipment may be subject to inspection at any time.

RACES

A total number of 12 races are scheduled.

Four races must be completed to constitute a series.

The spare day (Sunday, June 13th) will only be used if 4 races have not yet been completed.

On spareday there will be no warning signal after 14:55 hrs

SCORING

The low-point point system WR appendix A apply.

When fewer than 5 races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores.

When from 5 to 7 races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding the worst score.

When 9 or more races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her two worst scores.

There is an overall ranking of all participating A-Cats

and an additional ranking for the Classic A-Cats.

In this Classic classification, only the places of the Classic boats relative to each other are taken into account.

BOAT PARK

Sailors who stay overnight at the campsite book the pitch themselves.

The billing is carried out directly with the campsite.

Reservation is urgently required. With the booking request absolutely specify "regatta participant".

Sailors that have booked an overnight stay at the Walchensee campsite, put their boat and trailer on the rented pitch.

Sailors who do **not** stay overnight at the campsite and only need a parking place for boat and trailer should tick the corresponding box when registering via raceoffice.

The price for boat, trailer and sailor is **9 EUR / day**. The amount shall be transferred separately to the account of Segelfreunde Walchensee, see above, with the note "Parking place A-Cat; sail number; number of days"

A parking place is only booked after payment has been received.

Because of the parallel regatta "rund um's Walchenfass" (only Saturday and Sunday) maybe there are some berths on the club property of the "Walchensee Sailing Friends" in Einsiedl.

Arriving sailors shall follow the instructions of helpers at all times, please.

PRIZES

Prizes will be awarded to .

- the top five 5 of the international ranking
- the top 3 of the national German ranking
- the top 3 of the international Classic ranking
- the first of the national German Classic ranking

The "Walchenfass" challenge cup will be awarded to the German participant with the lowest points either in the overall ranking or in the Classic ranking.

DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk.

See RRS 4. Decision to Race.

The organizing authority and its officers, members and volunteers will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

The establishment of the Notice of Race and the sailing Instruction in no way limits or reduces the complete and unlimited responsibilities of a competitor being solely and entirely responsible for the management of a boat he is sailing.

A competitor shall maintain his boat in a safe and seaworthy condition.

A competitor shall be of good health and a competent sailor capable of racing an A-Class in open water. in strong winds and it his sole responsibility to decide to participate in a race or to continue racing.

A competitor is recommended to have personal accident and health insurance that covers them while attending the regatta and whilst racing.

PHOTOGRAPHY CONSENT

By entering the Championship competitors accept that they may be photographed and/or videotaped

participating in the race and/or using the regatta facilities and they consent to the taking of such images

and to the use, re-use, publication and republication of such images in any media, in conjunction with the

competitor's name or not, without compensation and without the competitor's approval of such images or

any use thereof.

SAFETY

The sailor of an A-Cat that can foil shall wear a safety helmet at all times while racing.

It is commended to wear distress signals (Nico signal or similar).

RADIO COMMUNICATION

Except in an emergency a boat that is racing shall neither make voice or data transmission and shall not receive voice or data transmission. This restriction also applies to mobile phones. [DP]

SUPPORT BOATS

Support boats are not allowed on Lake Walchensee.
